- Manage the integrity of the MI extraction and analysis process to ensure all data and reports are accurate, current, complete, and consistent.
- Prepare accurate, clear, and professionally presented reports and ensure these are completed within specified requirements and client agreed SLAs.
- Analyse data collected to help inform business decisions
- Support new business pitches by articulating and demonstrating our MI offering
- Train and upskill client relationship managers in the interpretation of MI to help them deliver insights to secure additional business
- Provide support to internal teams to understand their reporting needs.
